Applying for Pupil Premium / Free School Meal Award (Year 3 – Year 6)

Children in the care of the local authority e.g. foster children, or of a voluntary organisation, cannot be considered for free school meals in Year 3 to Year 6, however they are still entitled to the Universal Free School meals in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2.

You do not need to supply any documentary evidence of entitlement to Benefits – Dorset County Council can make automated checks.
