

British Values Awards

As part of our continual development of British Values across the curriculum we have decided to create these whole school awards for good Community Citizens.

Governors, teachers and teaching assistants may nominate individuals at any time for a bookmark and a roll call of honour will be announced in Monday Whole School Assemblies. Each awards assembly will be photographed and the children's photo placed on the British Values display.

Once you have collected all five bookmarks the children will earn a Community Citizen Medal/badge.

In each of the next academic years there will be 5 more school awards to collect and once achieved they will receive another medal – each year a different shape/colour – 7 to collect.

Democracy

This can be awarded to Children who:

- Listens to and values opinions
- Makes thoughtful choices
- Shows the ability to consider facts/evidence and makes good choices
- Expresses their opinion and suggests good ideas for improvement.

Rule of Law

This can be awarded to Children who:

- Display consistent good behaviour
- Always polite and respectful
- Demonstrates positive application of the different School Charters.
- Shows a good understanding of the consequences to peoples actions
- Shows respect and understanding for the Emergency services and other people who govern the class, school or country

Individual Liberty

This can be awarded to Children who:

- Make brave and bold choices, try new things/opportunities within the safety of the school environment
- Follows the Rights and Responsibilities contained within our UNICEF Rights Respecting School
- As a reward for their work/choices made at an extra-curricular club or outside agency/club

Mutual Respect

This can be awarded to Children who:

- follow the Behaviour Policy
- receive a Superstar Card
- Being courteous, considerate and caring to others
- Following a school/class charter.
- Help raise the self-esteem or confidence of others.

Tolerance of those of Different Faiths and Beliefs :

This can be awarded to Children who:

- Work with excellence, thoughtfulness and understanding in R.E. and P.S.H.E. lessons.
- Show appreciation and understanding of different cultures and beliefs
- Show an understanding of international/global issues
- Participation in religious-led groups/assemblies etc
