Arrangements for Free School Meals

If your child is in receipt of free school meals, this does not include the Government Funded meals for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, we are arranging with WeyCo, our meal provider, to deliver packed lunches to school. Our catering staff will distribute the packed lunches; they can be collected between **9am and 10am** daily, from the school car park. Please only use this service if you and your family are not self isolating, we must ensure the health and wellbeing of everyone. This service will continue until **Friday 3rd April** and will restart after the Easter holidays, as long as supplies are available. We will update you with any changes regarding this service as and when we are informed by our meal provider.
