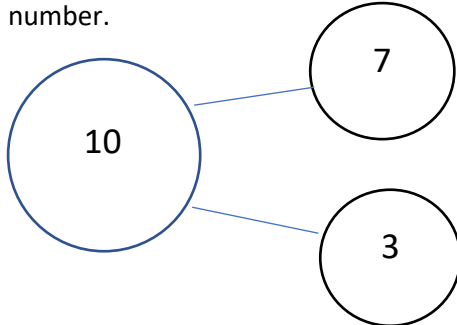


Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> May

Today we are looking at addition and subtraction using a bar model and a part / part / whole model – this is just another way of showing the children how two numbers can be combined to make a new number.



$$7+3=10$$

$$3+7=10$$

$$10=3+7$$

$$10=7+3$$

$$10-7=3$$

$$10-3=7$$
