



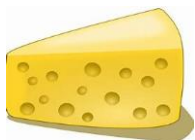
# School Lunches at St. George's Primary



We want to make sure that we are providing your child with the best education and support we can. Healthy school food has obvious health benefits and can help pupils establish healthy habits for life. A healthy diet can also help to improve pupils' readiness to learn.



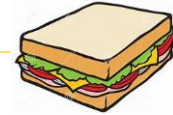
The menu changes every term and is available from the main school office or on the school website. The menus all conform to the Government food and nutritional standards. An allergens sheet is available to assist you in ordering lunches if your child has any special dietary requirements. If you are at all concerned you can discuss this with a member of the Weyco Catering team.



Pupils do not have to take up school lunches, they can bring in a packed lunch from home or you may wish to alternate. If at any time your child decides they no longer want school lunches please can you delete their order online or contact the school so that future orders can be removed.



Weymouth College are our provider for school lunches. Meals are ordered a week in advance and are delivered fresh every day. A selection of cold packed lunches is available as an alternative to a hot meal or when your child is attending a school trip. The cost of a school lunch is £2.40. Meals must be ordered and paid for in advance.



School Lunches are ordered through our online facility **SchoolMoney – Eduspot**. There is a parent guide available to assist you. If you haven't got access to the internet please contact the main school office. Alternatively you can download the app onto your mobile phone.



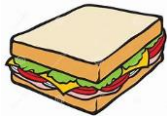


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## Universal Infant 'FREE' School Meals

In 2014 the Government introduced 'Infant Free School Meals' for every child in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. The online ordering system **SchoolMoney – Eduspot** will not charge you for any school lunches ordered if your child is in KS1.



## Reception Pupils starting in September

Reception pupils can start having school lunches on their **first full day** of the start of term.

As the children will be in part time for the first two weeks **orders will need to be placed during the first week that they attend school.** Forms will be sent home on the first day of term.



## Online Ordering for School Lunches

At St George's Primary School we have an online payment system called **SchoolMoney (Eduspot)**. The **SchoolMoney** payment system benefits both us as a school and you as a parent. Not only will you be able to order school lunches you can also pay for other items such as trips, swimming and music lessons online from the comfort of your own home.

You won't need to sign up to this system as this is done automatically as long as you have provided us with up to date contact details. We will send you a password within a week of your child starting school. For new Reception pupils this may take slightly longer. If you have not received this after 3 weeks please contact the school office on 01305 820520. A parent guide will be emailed to you.
