Key Stage Two: Friday 18th March, 2022

In the morning, children will take part in two sporting activities while representing their house colours.

In the afternoon, key stage two children (years 3, 4, 5 and 6) will be taking part in 'Chase the Bunny'. 'Chase the Bunny' will be a lung-busting obstacle course on the school field. A human-sized bunny will start approximately 100m in front. If the bunny is caught, that child will receive an Easter egg. All children will receive a certificate upon completion.
