Dear Parents and Carers,

We would like to welcome you all back to a new school year and we hope this brief newsletter will provide useful information for this term.

Reading and Spelling

All children will be issued with a reading book at their level and will be required to bring in their reading book every day. Please could you read with your child as often as possible. The reading records have the children's statutory spelling expectations for their year group printed inside (centre pages). They also have a handy area to log any particular words that you may notice your child finding tricky as they read. Every time your child completes a book they will be able to take a quiz to check their understanding of what they have read.

PE & Games

On Thursdays your child will need to come to school in PE kits for their games lesson.

PE kit should consist of a white t-shirt/polo shirt, blue or black shorts and a pair of trainers/plimsolls. In the colder months it is also a good idea for your child to have a plain tracksuit.

Please ensure your child's uniform and PE Kit are named clearly.

Homework

This year your children will have a weekly spelling and times table test. They will have some opportunity to practise them in school but they will also be required to learn these at home.

In addition to this, your child will be given a maths activity each week which will be posted on class dojo. Please can your child complete the activity by either taking a picture of their work and submitting it to class dojo or if it is easier completing it in the homework book they have been given and handing back to their teacher.

Homework will be set on a Friday and needs to be completed by the following Thursday. Times table tests and Spelling tests will be done every Friday.

We are always keen to meet with you to discuss any of your needs but we ask that you make an appointment through the office first. We can therefore give you the time that you require.
